## Lippincott Advisor & Procedures joins the CIAP collection to support healthcare professionals

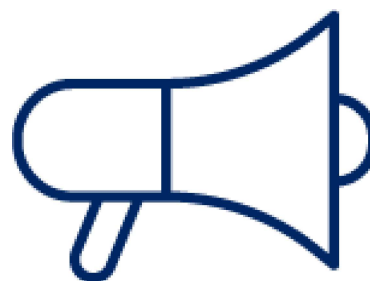
We are excited to announce that Lippincott Advisor & Procedures is now included in the CIAP collection.

Lippincott Procedures provides the HOW to support competency of nurses and midwives to integrate knowledge, skills, abilities, and judgments at the point of care.

This resource offers over 445 Australian procedures and competency assessments mapped to the NSQHS, 2000 US clinical procedures, videos, and images. It also provides skills checklists to document observation of competency demonstration, and supports education, training, and development from novice to expert.

## Changes to the CIAP collection

You will see some changes to the CIAP collection.

The CIAP team will work to support CIAP users by providing information via the CIAP website, newsletters, and CIAP Clinical Champions.

The decision to discontinue a number of resources followed analysis of statewide usage and cost as well as consultation with NSW Health clinicians and expert advisors.

It was determined that statewide licences to these resources were not demonstrating value for money due to high cost and low usage.
