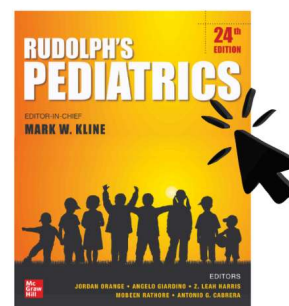

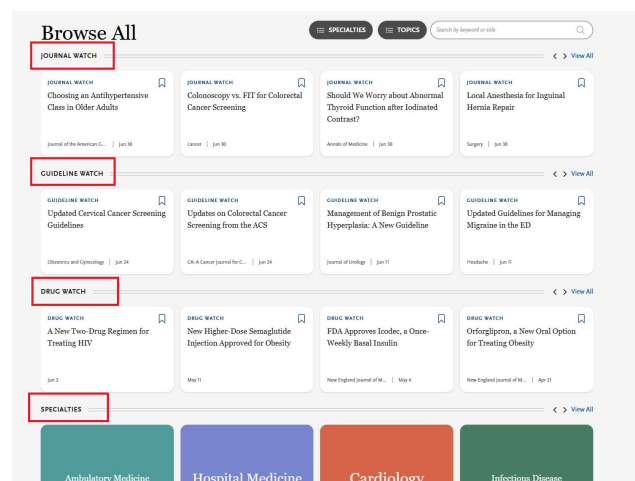


How Do Obesity Drugs Compare?

Several medications are now FDA-approved to treat obesity, with more in the pipeline, but limited head-to-head data exist to guide treatment decisions. To address this, researchers conducted a network meta-analysis of 260 randomized trials of obesity medications involving nearly 100,000 participants (median age, 49; median body-mass index, 35). Follow-up was a median of 26 weeks.
