Pediatric Care Online (PCO)

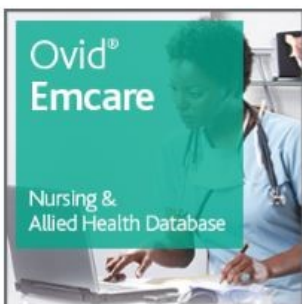
[Pediatric Care Online \(PCO\)](#) is a paediatric decision support tool from the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP). Designed for health professionals at the point of care, PCO provides access to:

- evidence-based clinical information
- a repository of supporting reference material
- patient information
- over 100 Key Practice Points
- advice on 'red flag' signs and symptoms
- a downloadable app.

Emcare on Ovid



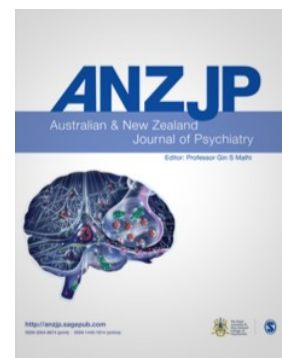
