What Is The Diagnosis?

This x-ray shows fluid collecting between the parietal and visceral pleural surfaces of the thorax.

A thin layer of fluid is always present in this space for lubrication and ease of movement of the lung during inspiration and expiration.

If the normal flow of fluid is disrupted, with either too much fluid produced or not enough removed, then fluid accumulates.
