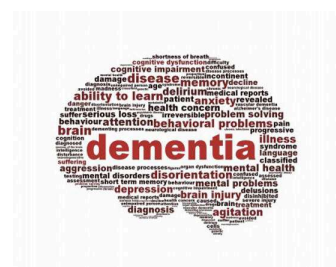
What Are The Effects Of Cognitive Training For People With Mild To Moderate Dementia?
